SCHOOL GUIDE

1. It is good for Learners to report to school on the first day of each term, except in special cases
2. Silence Hour (reading silently) is observed each morning between 7.30 and 7.45am. Assembly is at 7.45am.
3. Class registration is at 8am. If a Learner comes to school after the register is marked, it means they would have been marked absent.
4. It is important for Parents to provide all necessary writing tools and ensure that Learners bring them to school all the time.

5. **Children's homework need supervision from Parents or**
6. **guardians who will add their signature, and encourage Learners to be responsible for their text and exercise books at home**
7. **Children who wish to celebrate their birthdays will do so at the end of month, or on the last Friday of the month.**
8. **It is important that Parents or guardians inform class teachers whenever a child has symptoms of ill health**
9. **An unhealthy child needs to rest at home. No sick child should be brought to school.**
10. **It is right for Parents to sew the approved style of the school uniform if they have to. All children will look the same.**
11. **Black shoes and white socks or black sandals match with school uniforms. A child will look different in other colours of shoes and socks.**
12. **The outfits for Physical Education or Taekwondo match with sneakers or trainers, not sandals. Learners will change back into their school uniforms after their PE lessons.**
13. **Children will wear the school Lacoste and their own blue jeans trousers or skirt on Fridays.**
14. **Boys and girls will trim and comb their hair. Girls in braids will tie them to the back neatly or be in cornroll.**
15. **Finger nails will be kept trimmed and clean always.**
16. **Children will brush their teeth before coming to school.**
17. **The following offences and related acts of indiscipline will attract special counselling and rebuke from both school and parents. Possession of harmful weapons, fighting, bullying, petty thieving or stealing, lying, disobeying teachers or any adult, disrespecting classmates, seniors or school prefects, use of profane language (verbal and nonverbal), deliberate damage to furniture, equipment or physical structure,**
18. **Failure to do homework or project work. Other forms of punishment would be sweeping, picking litter, or washing bowls.**

- 19. Learners will confine themselves to the school premises at all times.
- 20. Children will take their breakfast before coming to school, or have it in school before the Silence Hour.
- 21. The school will serve lunch and snacks daily.
- 22. It is advisable to keep food hot in food flasks and not plastic bowls, if a child does not subscribe to school feeding.
- 23. If a child must be absent on any day, the school will be informed via phone call or in writing where the absence is planned for many days.
- 24. Parents or guardians will be invited on some days to interact with teachers, and know the state of their children.
- 25. Learners will be allowed to bring mobile devices when necessary.
- 26. Boys will use only boys' toilet, and girls will use only girls' toilet.
- 27. Children will not engage in any form of sexual harassment.
- 28. No parent or guardian will insult, fight or assault any teacher or worker in the school.
- 29. A parent or guardian will report any disturbing issue to the school authorities.
